Some characteristics of employment in the informal sector of manufacturing and services




economic water scarcity


physical water scarcity


Economic water scarcity is where lack of development limits people's access to water even though water is available.


Physical water scarcity is where the use of water by people is approaching or exceeding the sustainable limit.


