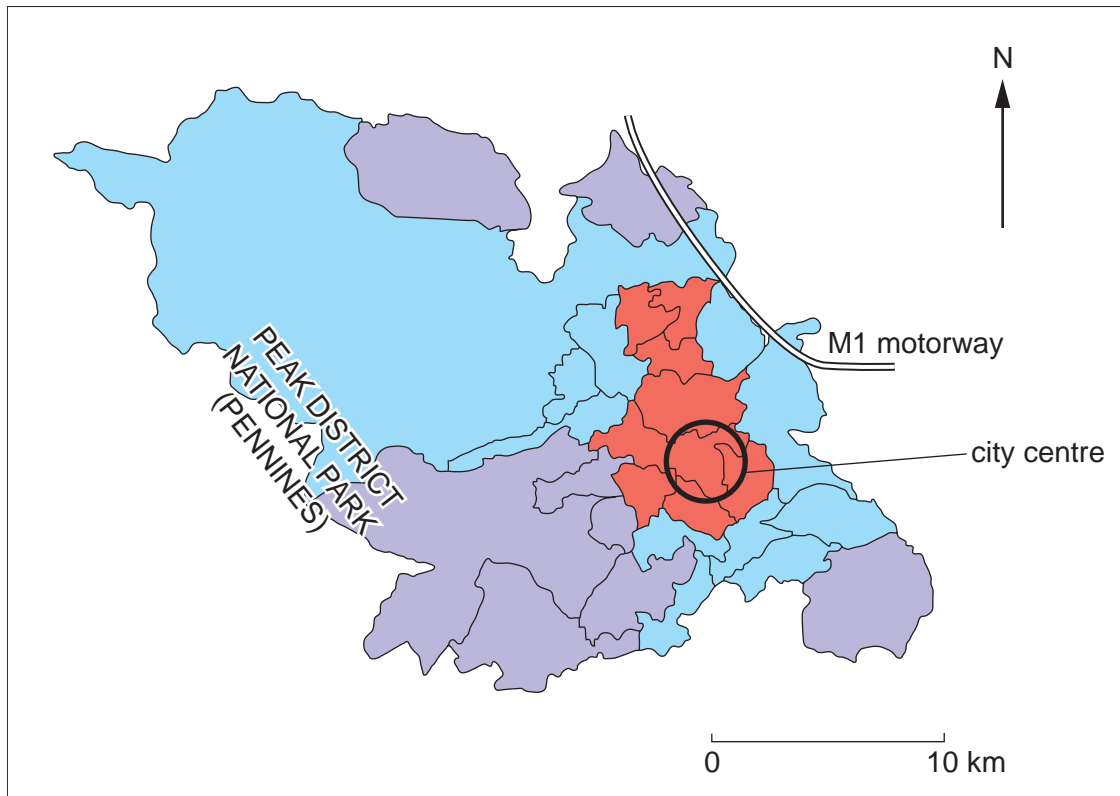

Fig. 2 Major population movements from rural areas in North-East Brazil (1985 – 2005)

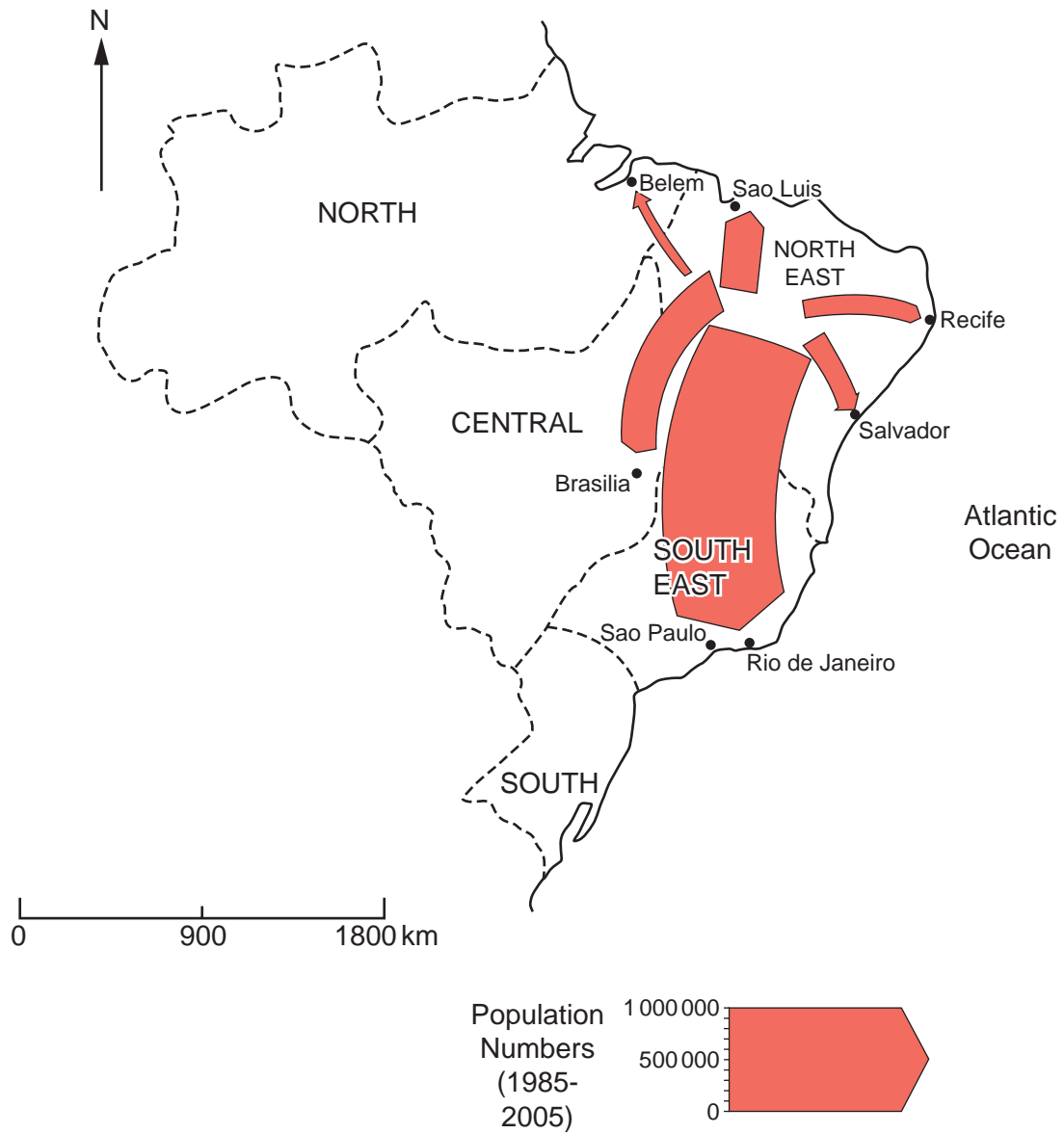


Fig. 3 Global sources of energy

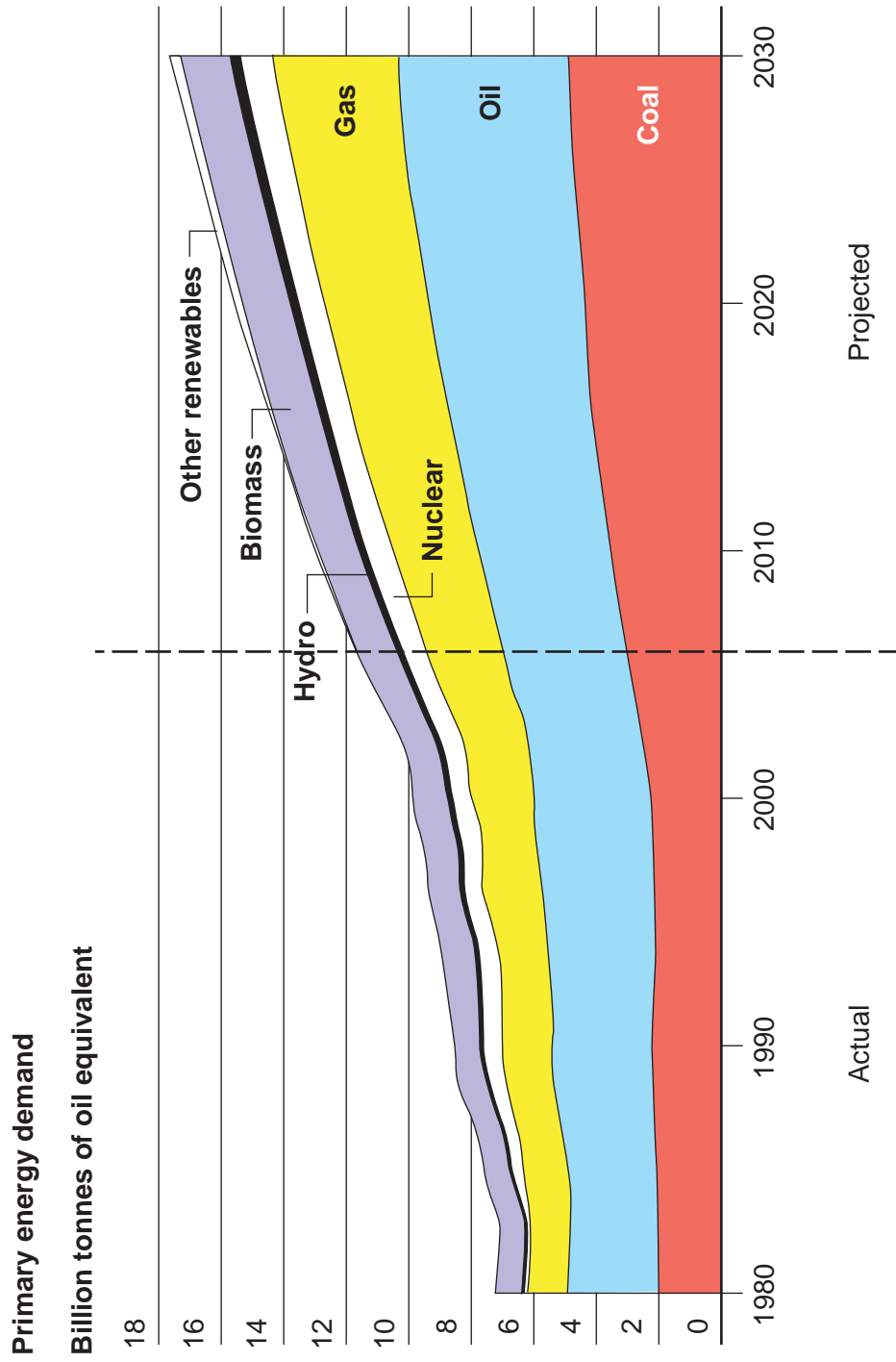
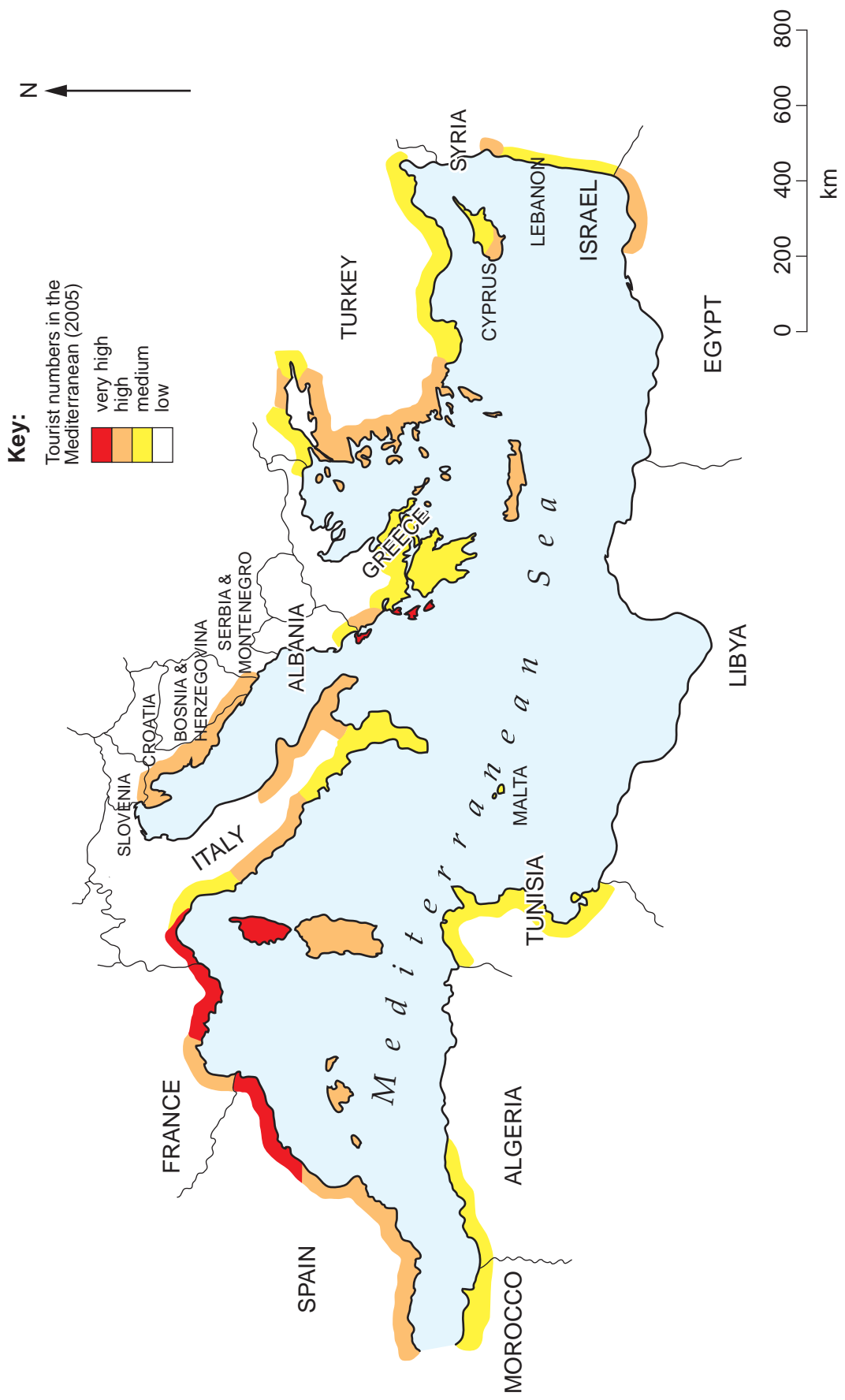


Fig. 4 Tourist numbers along the Mediterranean coast (2005)
