1 Sarah and Jack experiment with two hand-held radios.



- (a) The radio waves have a frequency of 446 MHz and speed of 3.0×10^8 m/s.
 - (i) Explain why Sarah and Jack cannot see the radio waves.

(ii) Calculate the wavelength of the radio waves.

Use the equation: wavelength = wave speed ÷ frequency

Give your answer to 2 significant figures.

Wavelength = m

(b) Describe how electrical circuits in the radios can produce radio waves.
