Variation

Aim

Investigation into variation of organisms by categorising types of snails.

Equipment.

• Images of snails (See original <u>WJEC documentation</u>, p49)

Method

- 1. Place the images of woodland snails face down.
- 2. Randomly select 50 and categorise into these four categories: pink, plain; yellow, plain; pink, striped; yellow, striped
- 3. Repeat the procedure for another habitat
- 4. Draw a bar chart of the results and evaluate the differences in the 2 environments.
