An element is a substance made up of only one type of atom.

Oxygen and copper are examples of an element









What is a compound? Give examples of a compound









What is a compound? Give examples of a compound

Compound is a substance made from two or more elements that have reacted with each other and formed chemical bonds between atoms. Water (H₂O), carbon dioxide (CO₂) and sodium chloride (NaCl) are compounds.









What is a mixture? Give an example of a mixture











What is a mixture?

A mixture is a substance made up of two or more elements or compounds, but are not chemically bonded together.

Air (consisting of molecules such as nitrogen and oxygen) is an example of a mixture.
