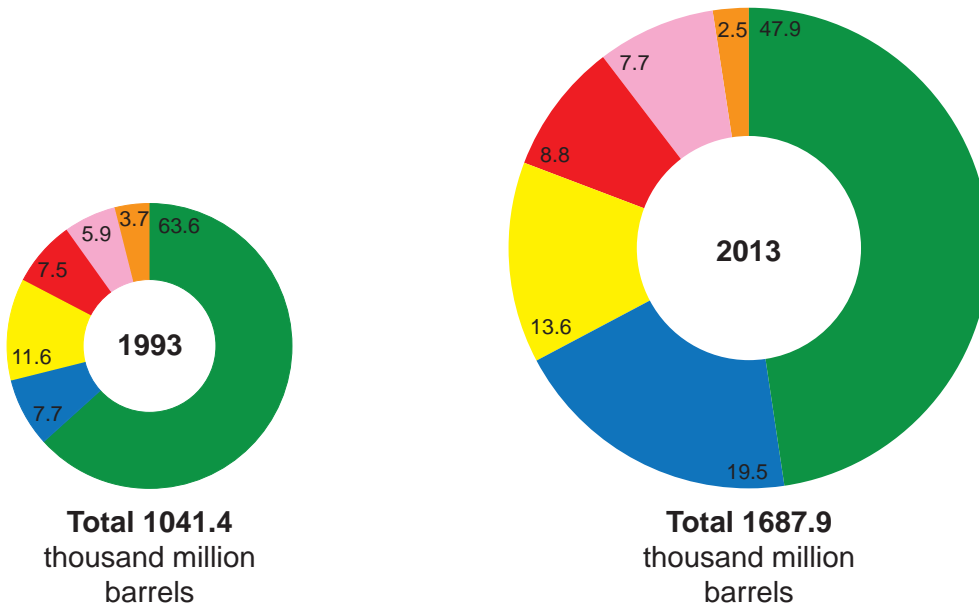

A product life cycle for a tourist destination

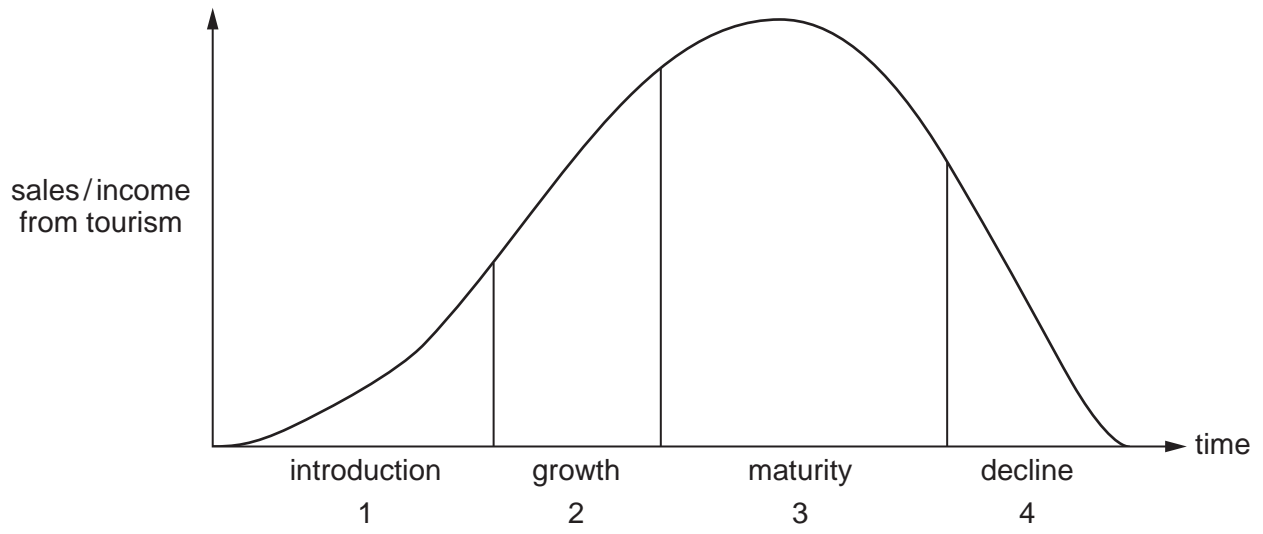
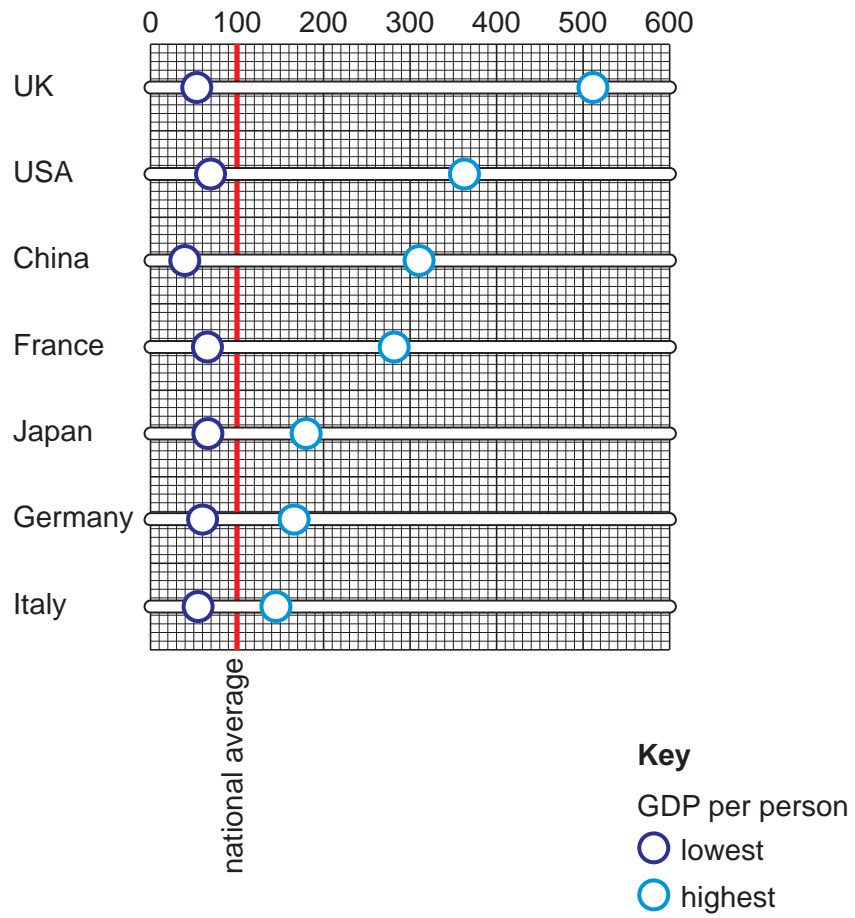
