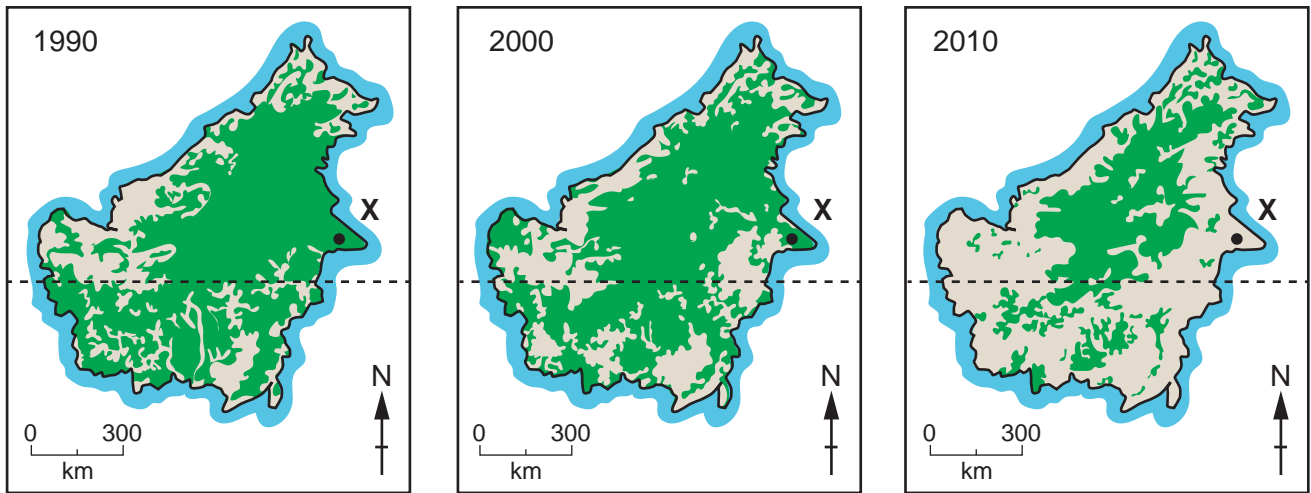

Nutrient cycling for location X in Fig. 1.1 before and after deforestation

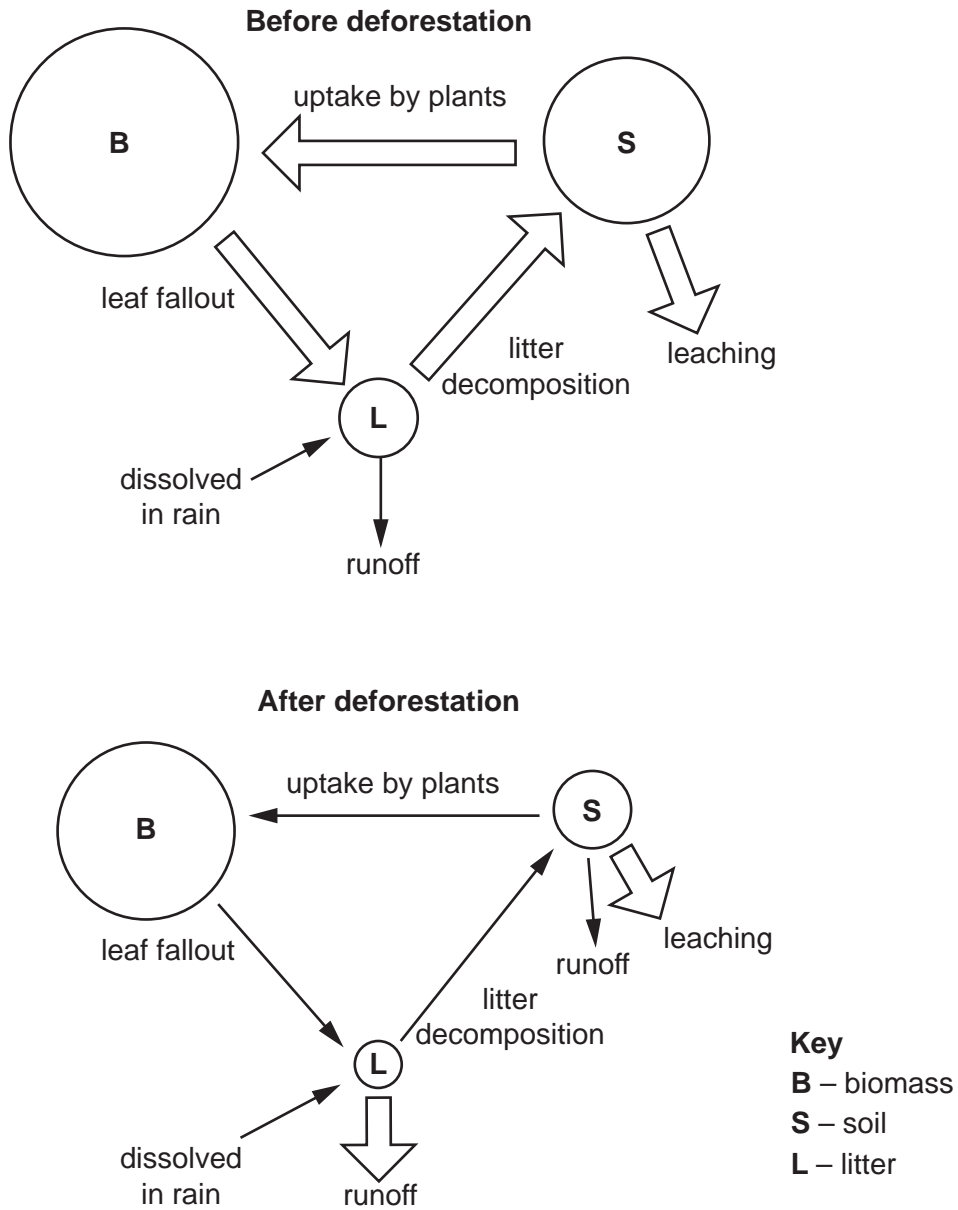

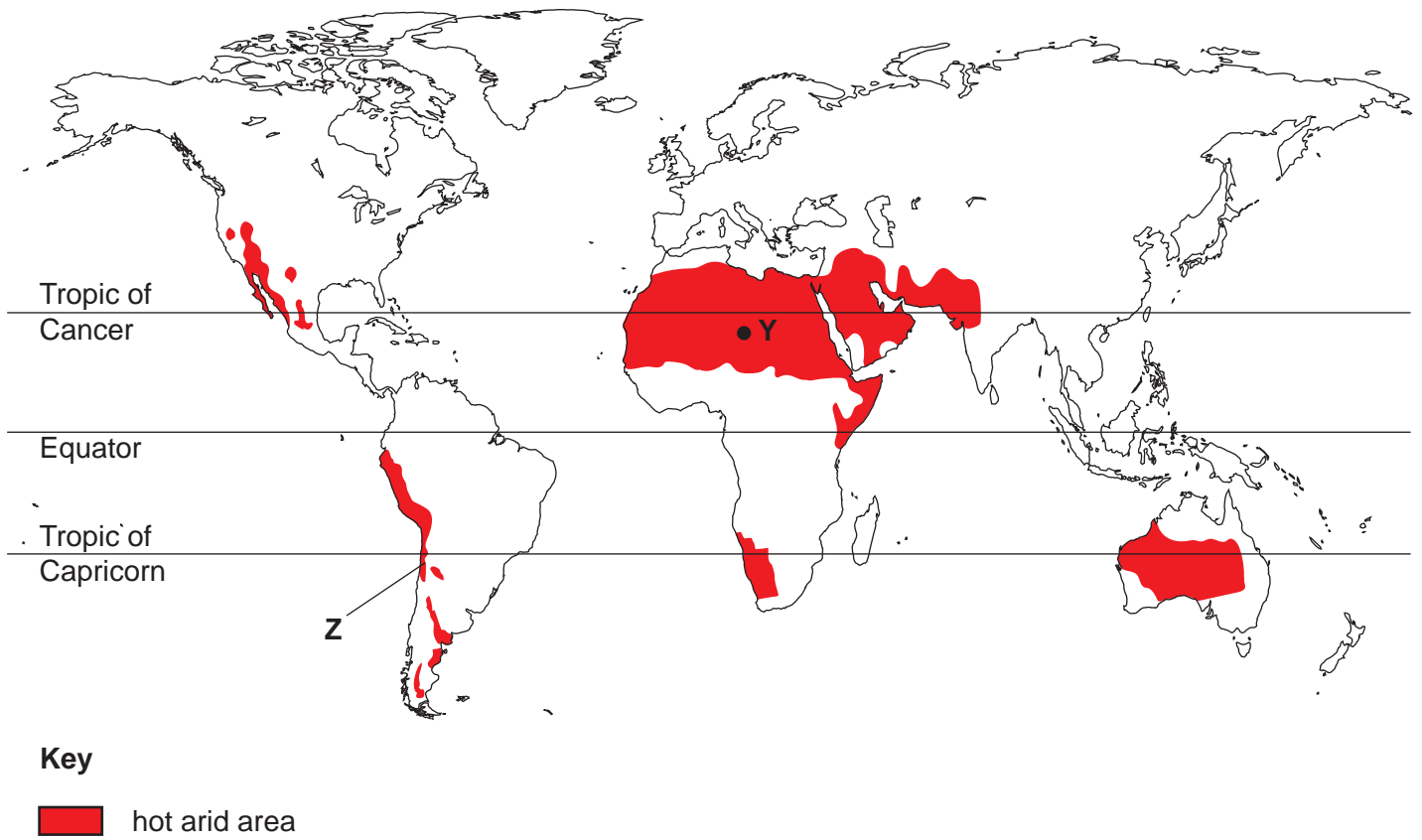
