## Food supply and food demand in Bangladesh, projected for 2030

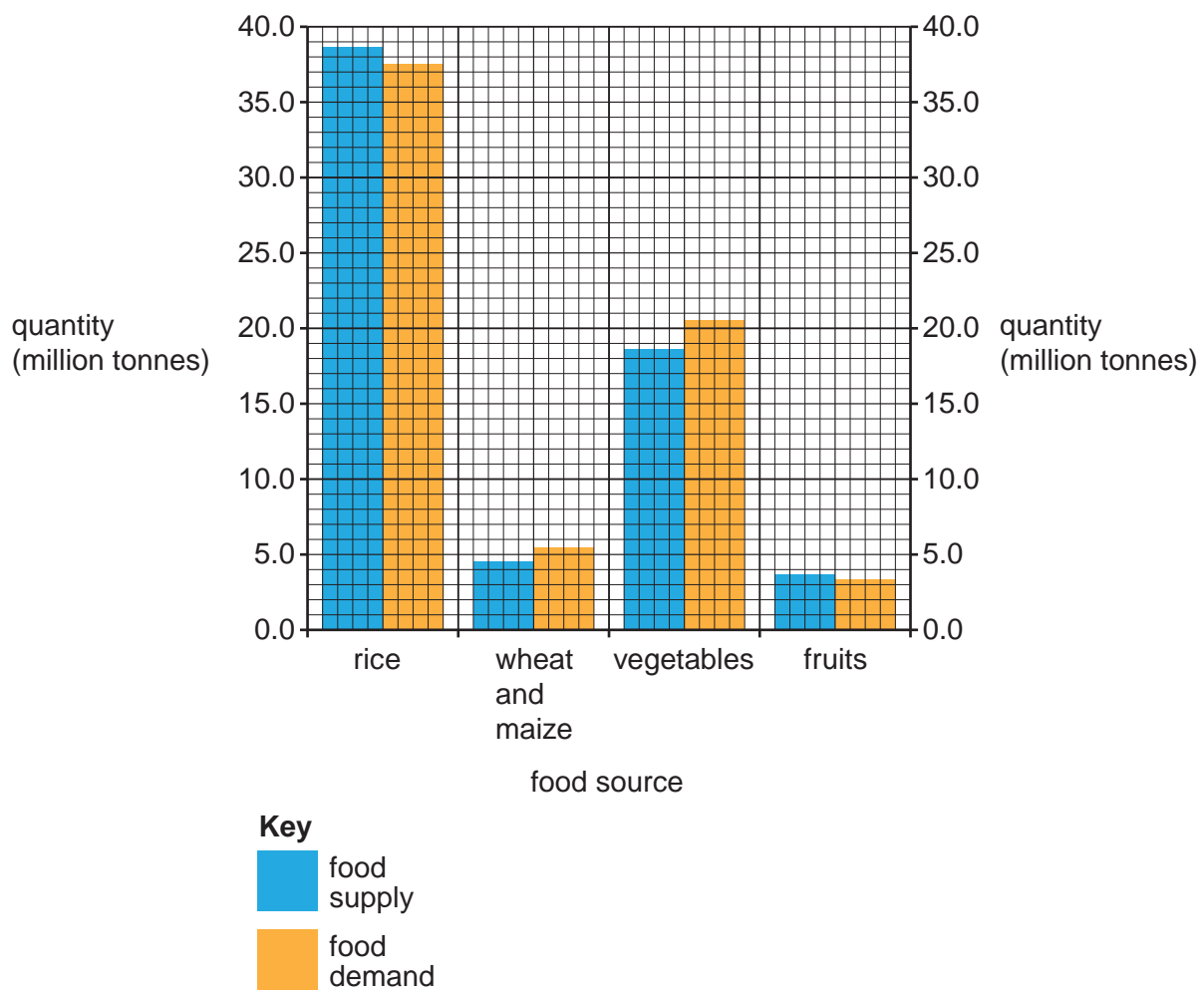
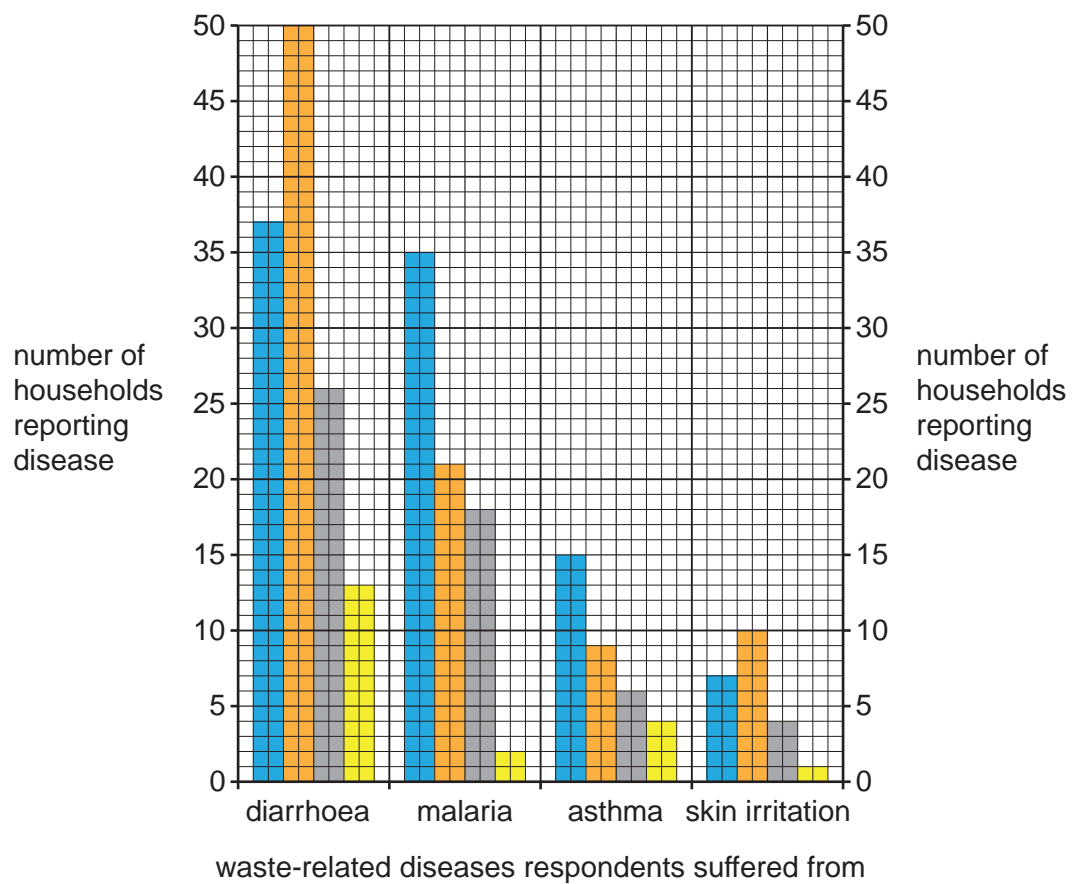

### Key

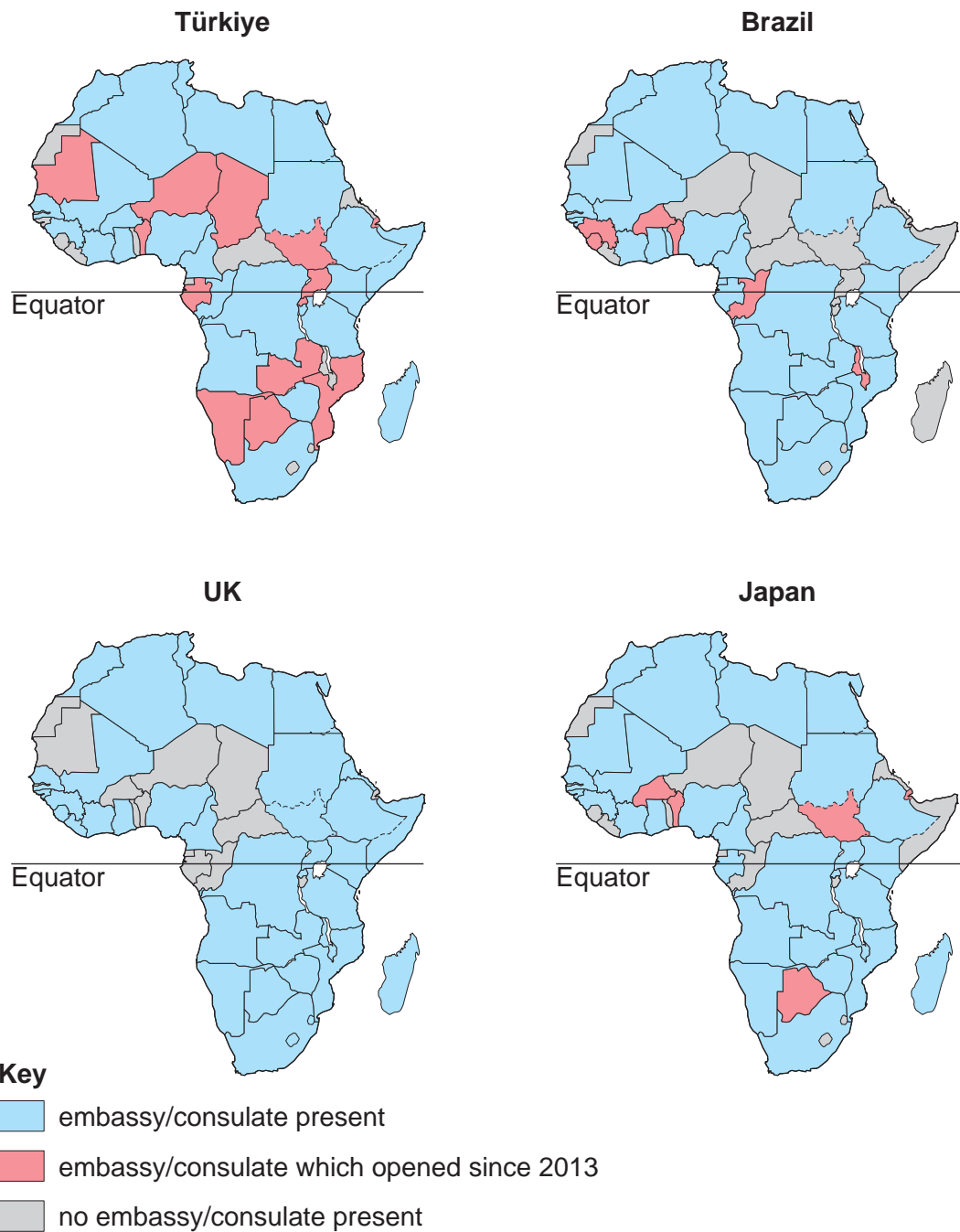
distance of household from an unplanned waste site

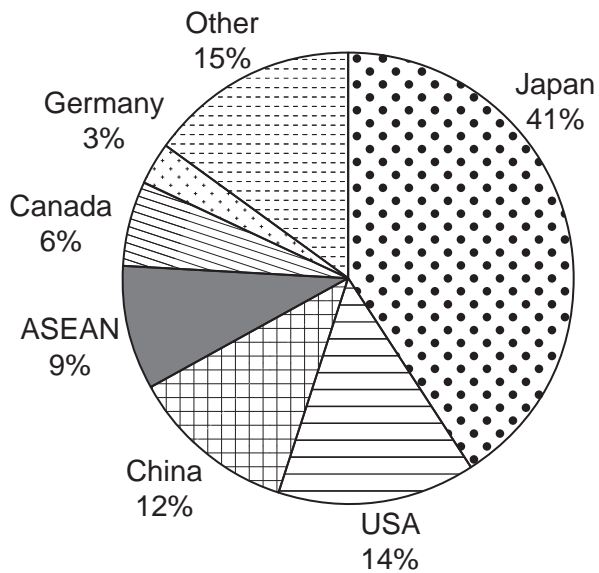

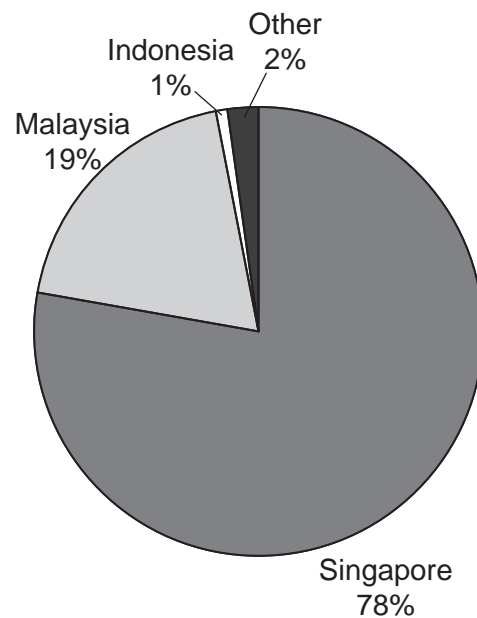
