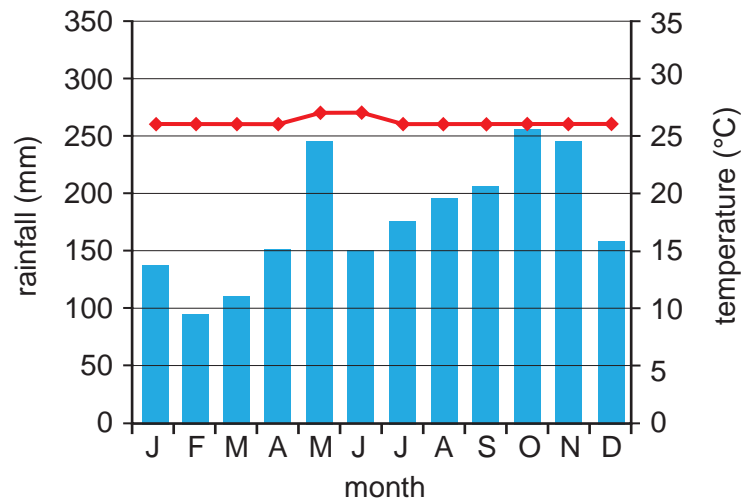

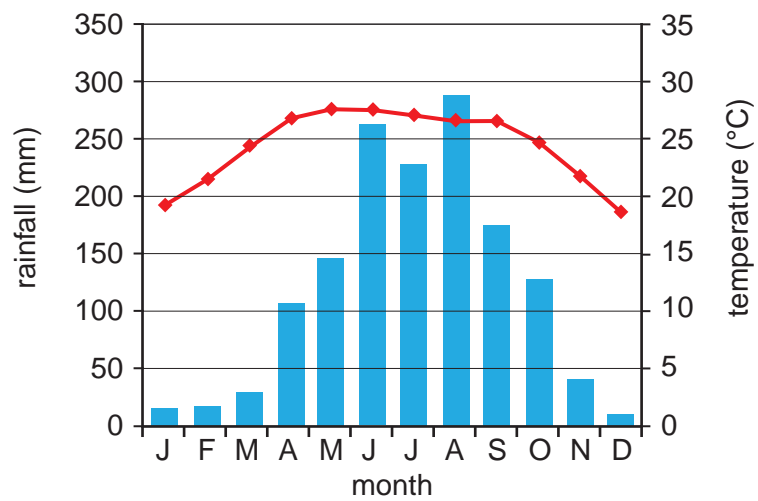

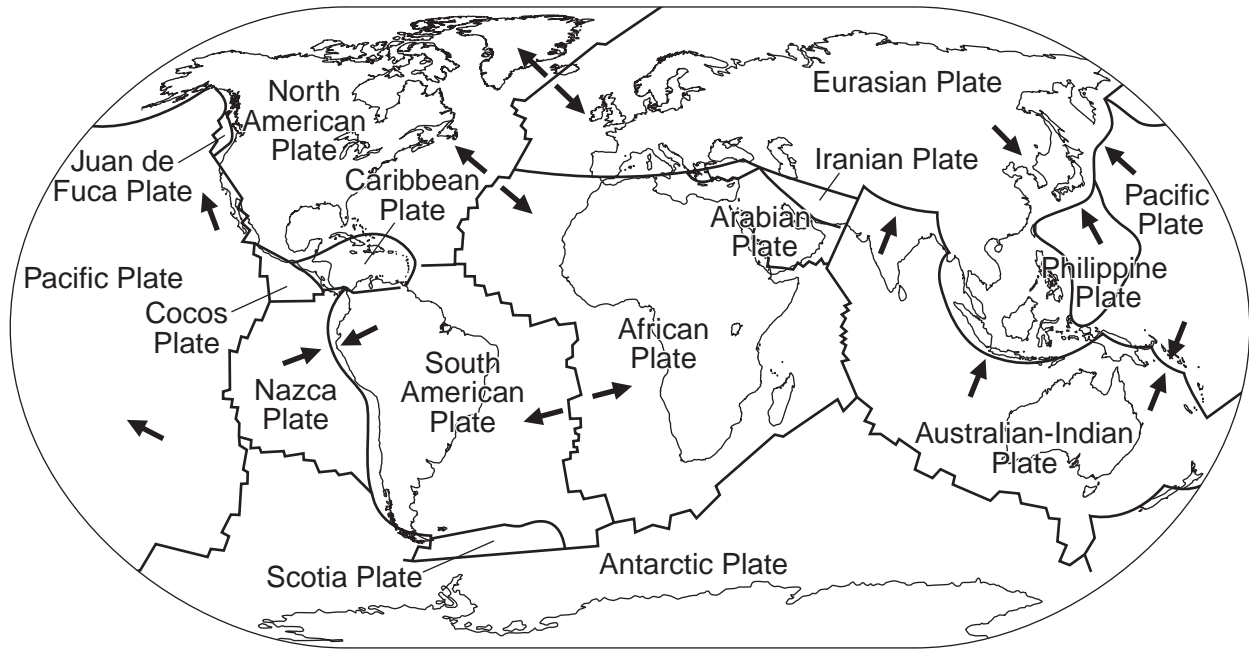

The distribution of tectonic plate margins



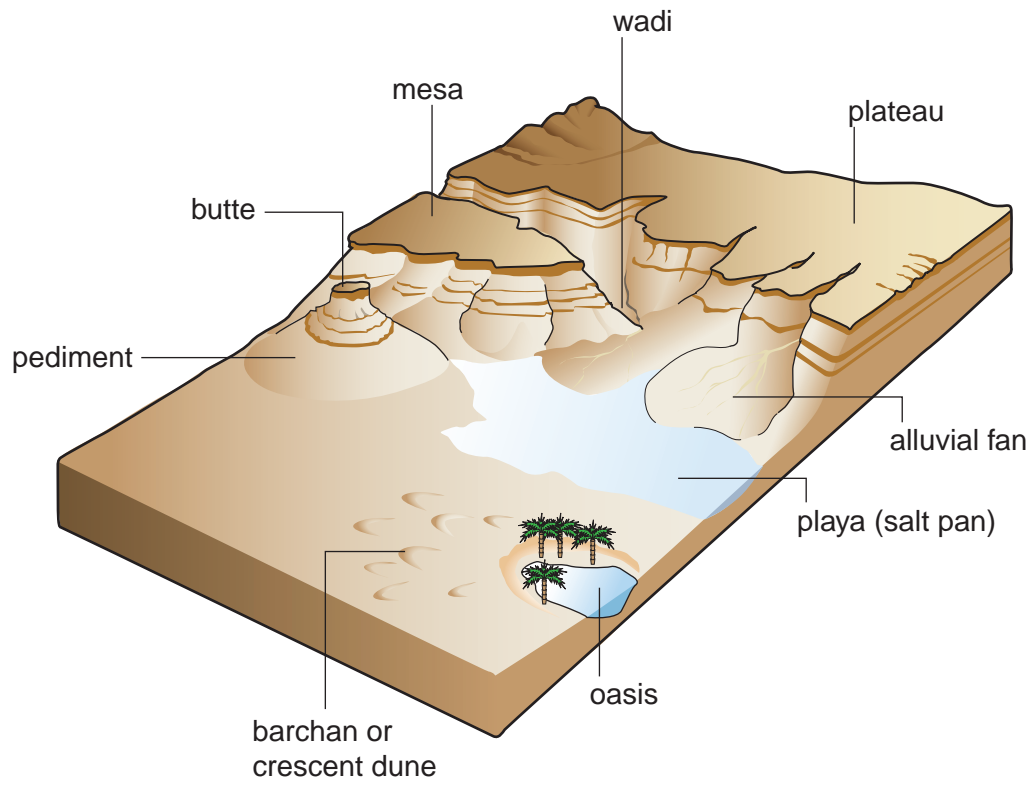
Key
