Fig. 3 – Value of international trade in US\$ per capita, by country, 2019.



Value of international trade in US\$ per capita = value of total trade (exports and imports) of goods and commercial services of a country in US\$ divided by total population.

Fig. 4 – Number of international migrants as a percentage of total population, by country, 2019.



International migrants as a percentage of total population = number of people living in a country other than that in which they were born divided by the total population.

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
