Phase 1 - 1990 to 1995 - new sea wall, stabilise the cliffs

Phase 2 - 2005 to 2007 - replenished beach, rock armour extended

Phase 3 - cancelled - risks to Monmouth Beach too great

Phase 4 - 2015 to 2017 - sea wall extended, cliffs stabilised & drained

Phase 5 - future - repair promenade and wall in The Cobbs
