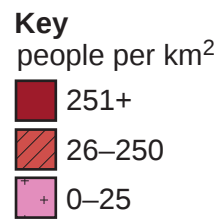
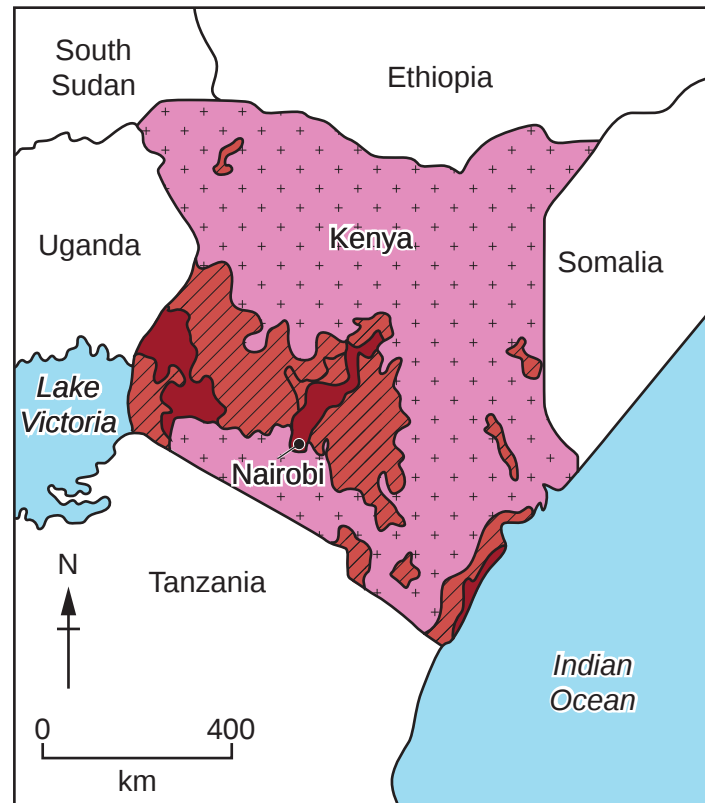
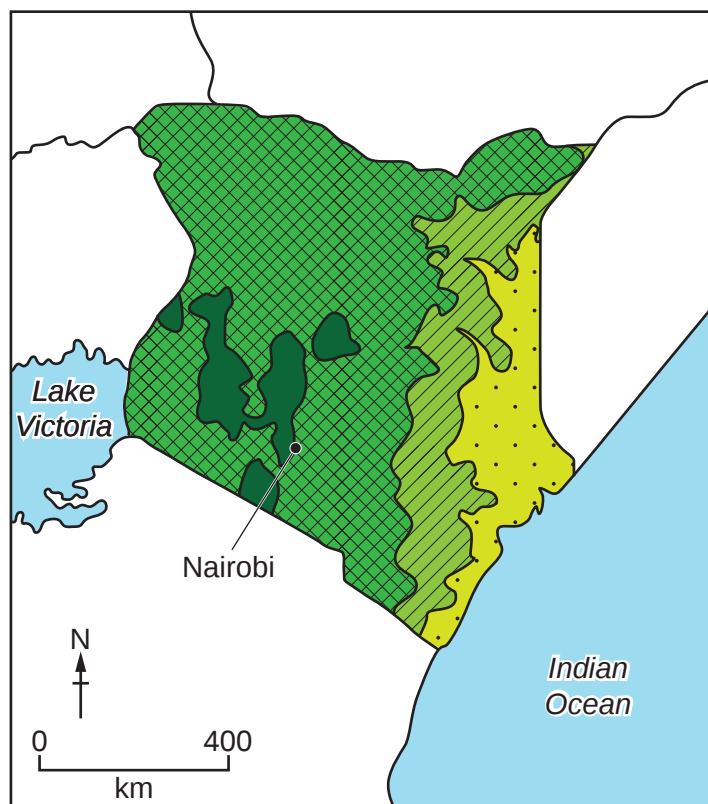

height above sea level (m)

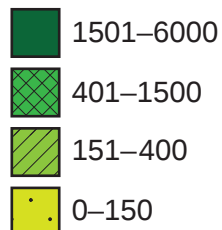
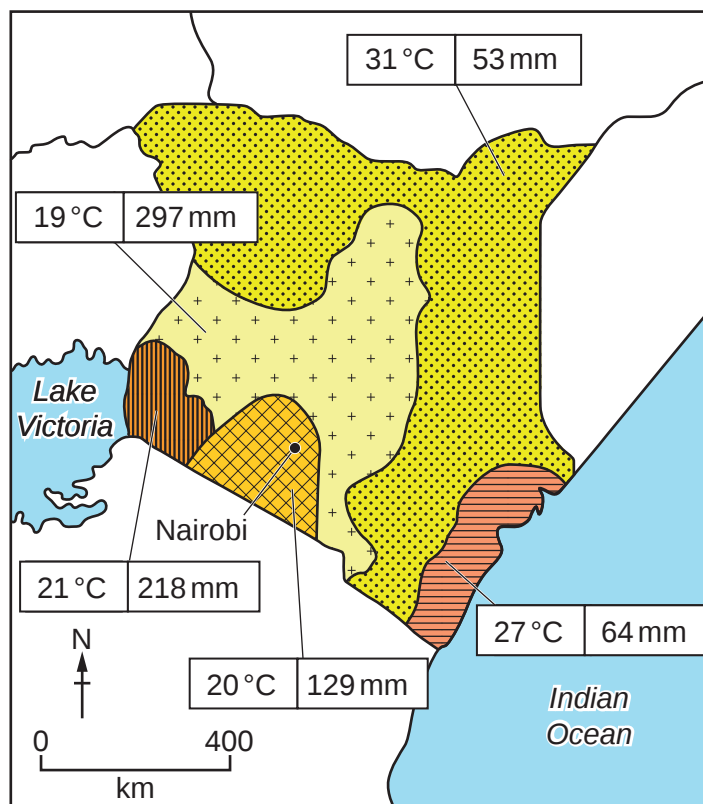

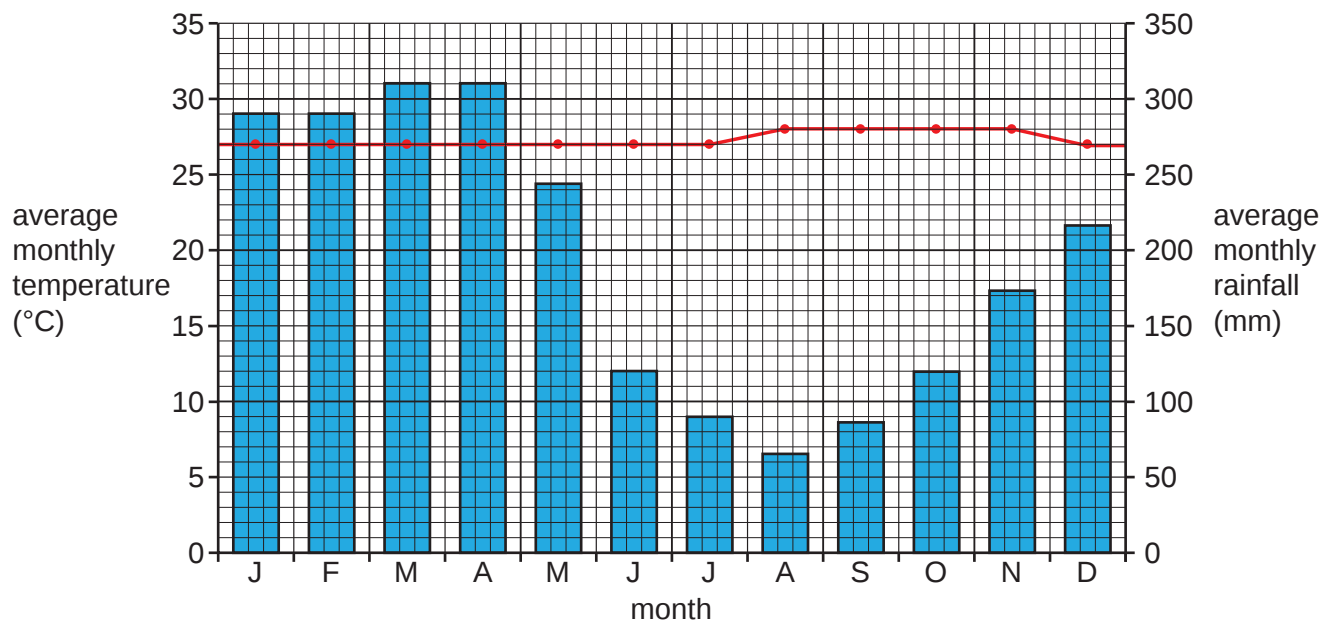
