







Meadowhall, Sheffield – an example of ‘out of town’ retail



Since opening its doors in 1990, Meadowhall has:



Contributed a total of £303m to public finances, with 18% of all business rates collected in Sheffield derived from Meadowhall



Created one job in every 100 in Sheffield City Region, directly and through the supply chain



Employed up to 8,500 people at the centre at peak times



Contributed £1.8m through our community programme over the last five years
