Extract 1: From John Ehrman, *The Eighties: America in the Age of Reagan*, published 2005.

It is clear that the changes of the 1980s were overwhelmingly for the good. The increased competition brought renewed innovation, rising productivity, and most important, an adjustment in how people were rewarded for their labours. That some benefitted more than others should not obscure the major result, which for most people was greater fairness, and more choices. For most Americans, the 1980s was a time of rising living standards. Retail sales rose by a third from 1980 to 1988. The critics missed the point. The rise in consumption brought real benefits to the mass of ordinary Americans. 5

Reagan also proved conclusively that conservatives could govern effectively. On his highest-priority issues, such as reducing taxes, controlling inflation, encouraging growth and innovation, Reagan worked carefully, and was almost always successful. Reagan also shifted some of the basic assumptions about American politics, especially regarding taxes, the growth of federal programmes, and the role of the market. This shift also had an impact on the policies of the Democrats. 10 15

Extract 2: From Norman Lowe, *Mastering Modern World History*, third edition, published 1997.

Reaganomics, as the president's policies became known, benefitted the wealthy but increased the tax burden on the poor. At the same time Reagan reduced social programmes to help the poor. During Reagan's second term in office he was dogged by economic problems, disasters, scandals and controversies. A serious depression in the agricultural Midwest was accompanied by falling prices, falling government subsidies and a rise in unemployment. 20

In October 1987 a severe stock market crash occurred, brought on by the fact that the American economy was in serious trouble. There was a huge budget deficit, mainly because Reagan had more than doubled defence spending since 1981, while at the same time cutting taxes. During the period 1981 to 1987, the national debt more than doubled. The USA had the largest trading deficit of any leading industrialised country, and the economy was beginning to slow down as industry moved into recession. In spite of all this, Reagan somehow managed to retain his personal popularity. 25 30
