



Significantly, the world's first bumb earane programme was undertaken in Hamburg in 1893, while at the some time many German is ties were hair ng a range of amenities in alled.

The new o nditions to imulated the development of work ng-b as movements. Workers of uld to e both the wealth that they had to eated for others and the propect of more material pose is one for themselves, each of which end uraged them to demand higher pay. At the time, their working hours and onditions led them to demand improvements from their employers.
