Use Source A and your own knowledge to describe the Nazi consolidation of power between 1933 and 1934. [6]

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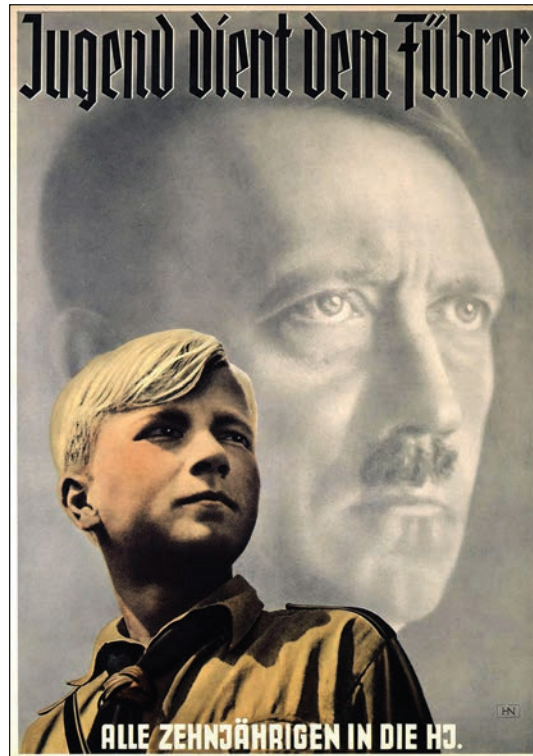
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QUESTION 3
