

1 Here are three calculations, A, B and C.

A
 $100 \times 20\,000$

B
 $1 \text{ million} \div 2$

C
 $4 \times 100\,000$

Put the calculations in order.

Start with the calculation that has the smallest answer.

You **must** show the answer to each calculation.

[3 marks]

$A : 100 \times 20\,000 = 2\,000\,000$ (1)

$B : 1\,000\,000 \div 2 = 500\,000$

$C : 4 \times 100\,000 = 400\,000$ (1)
