Describe the process of conduction (supplement)

- Solid/liquid is heated
- Particles vibrate more
- Energy is transferred to adjacent molecules via collisions, transferring energy from hot to cold regions

In fluids (liquids and gases).

Describe the process of convection.

- When a section of fluid is heated, it becomes less dense
- This causes it to rise
- Denser fluid falls to take its place and is then heated, causing it to rise
- This sets up a convection current

What factors affect the amount of IR emitted by a body? (supplement)

- Temperature (higher = more IR)
- Surface area (larger = more IR)
