by the Earth's surface and reflected by clouds

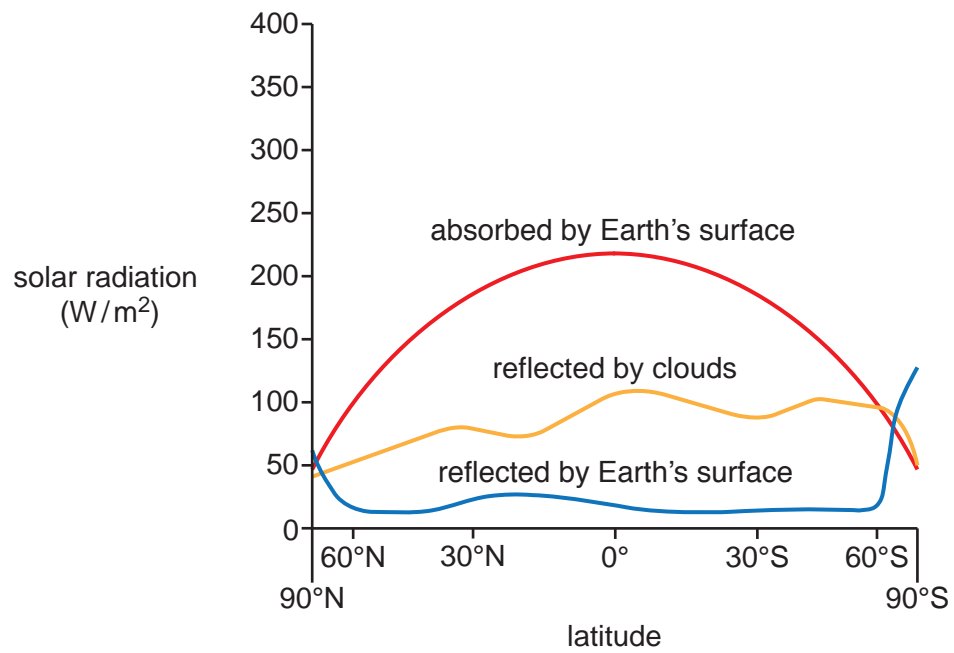
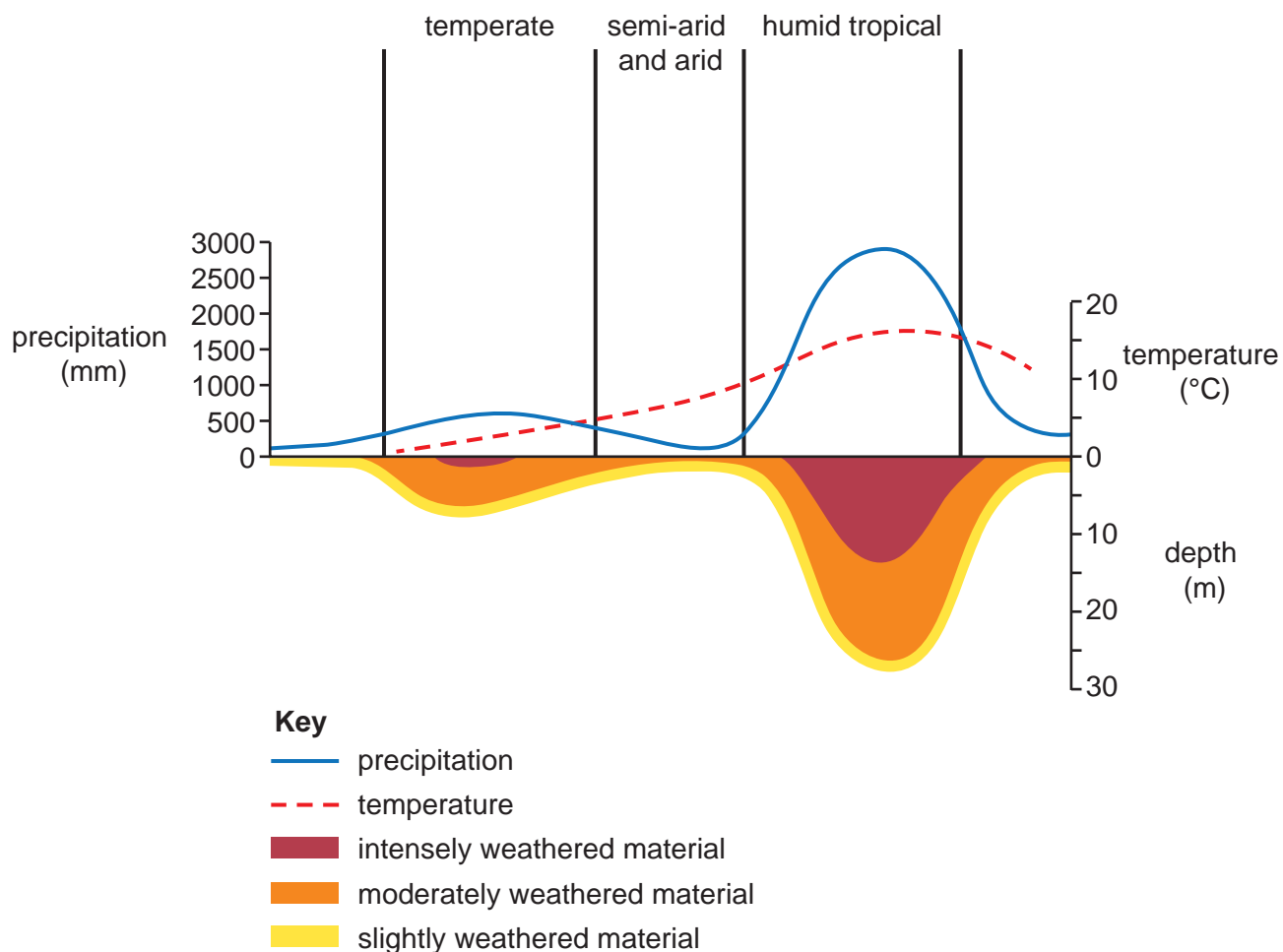
