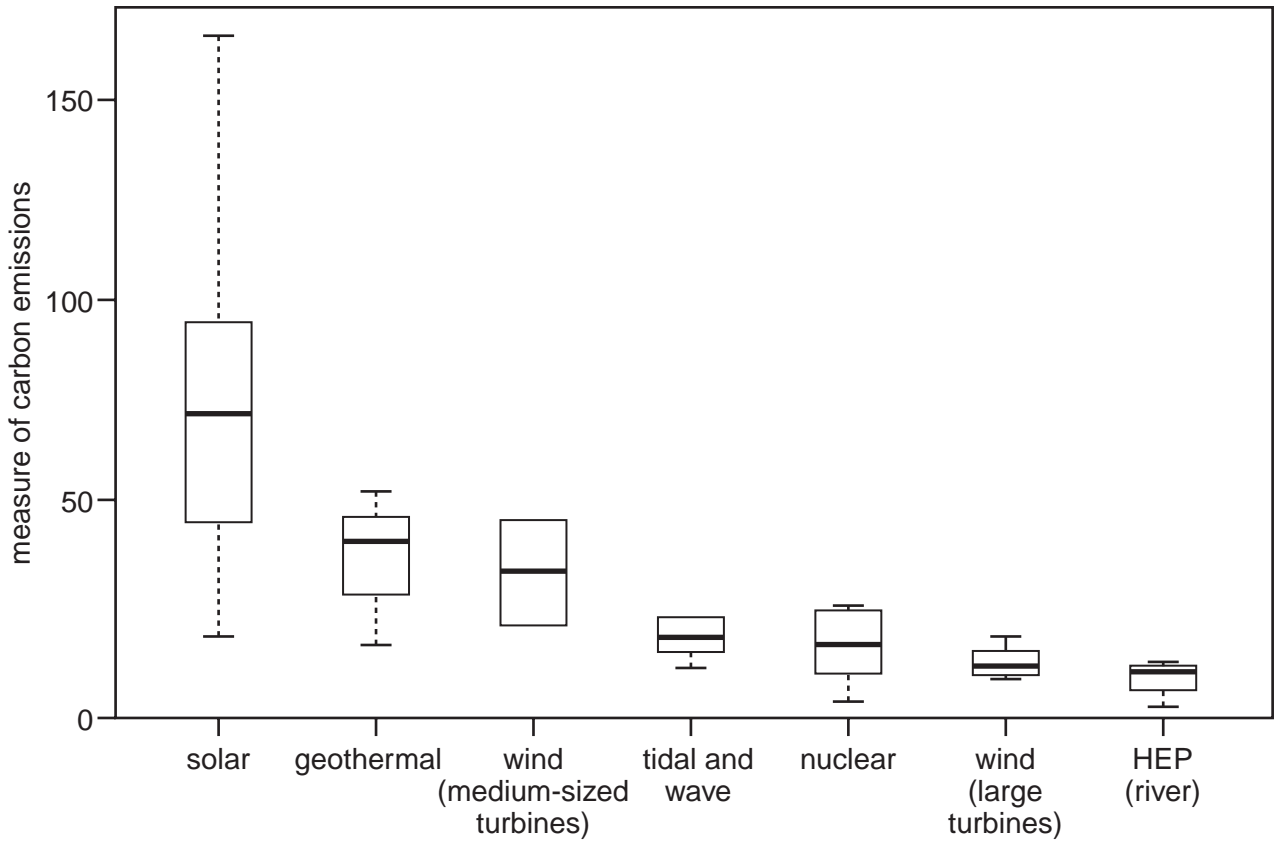

- lowest estimate

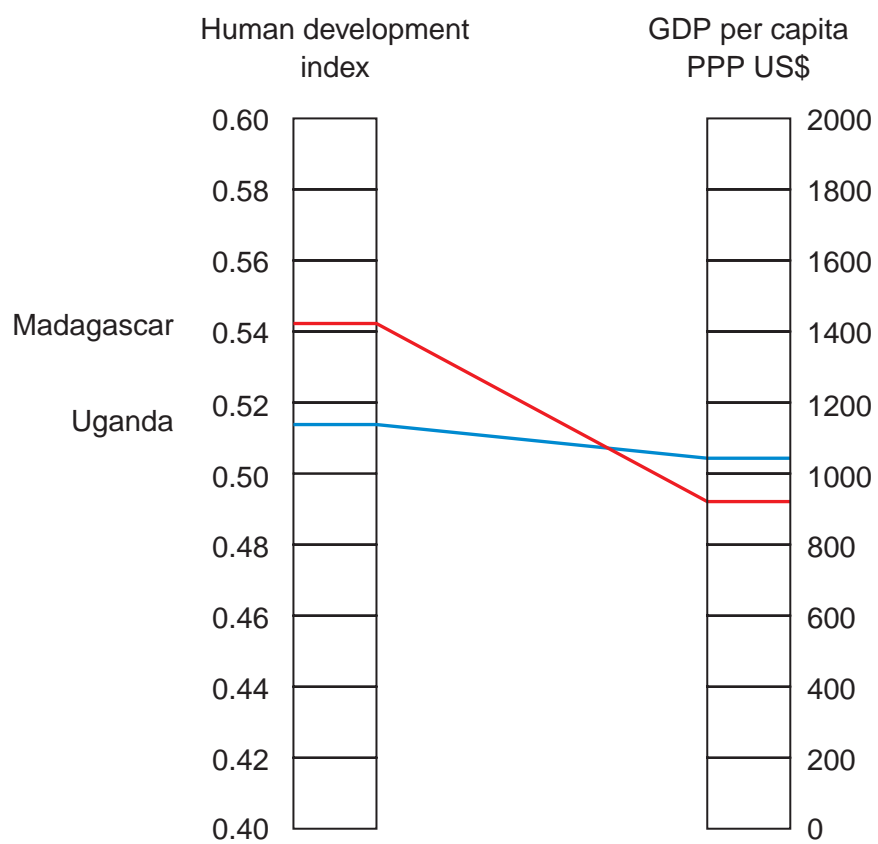
