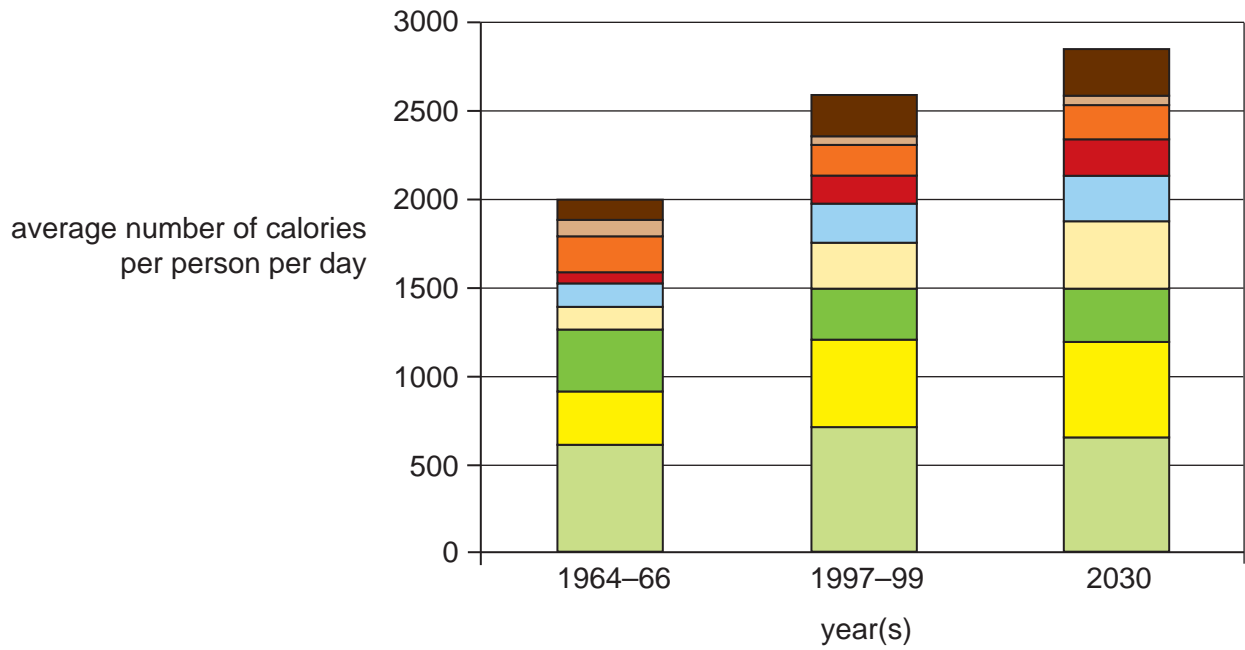

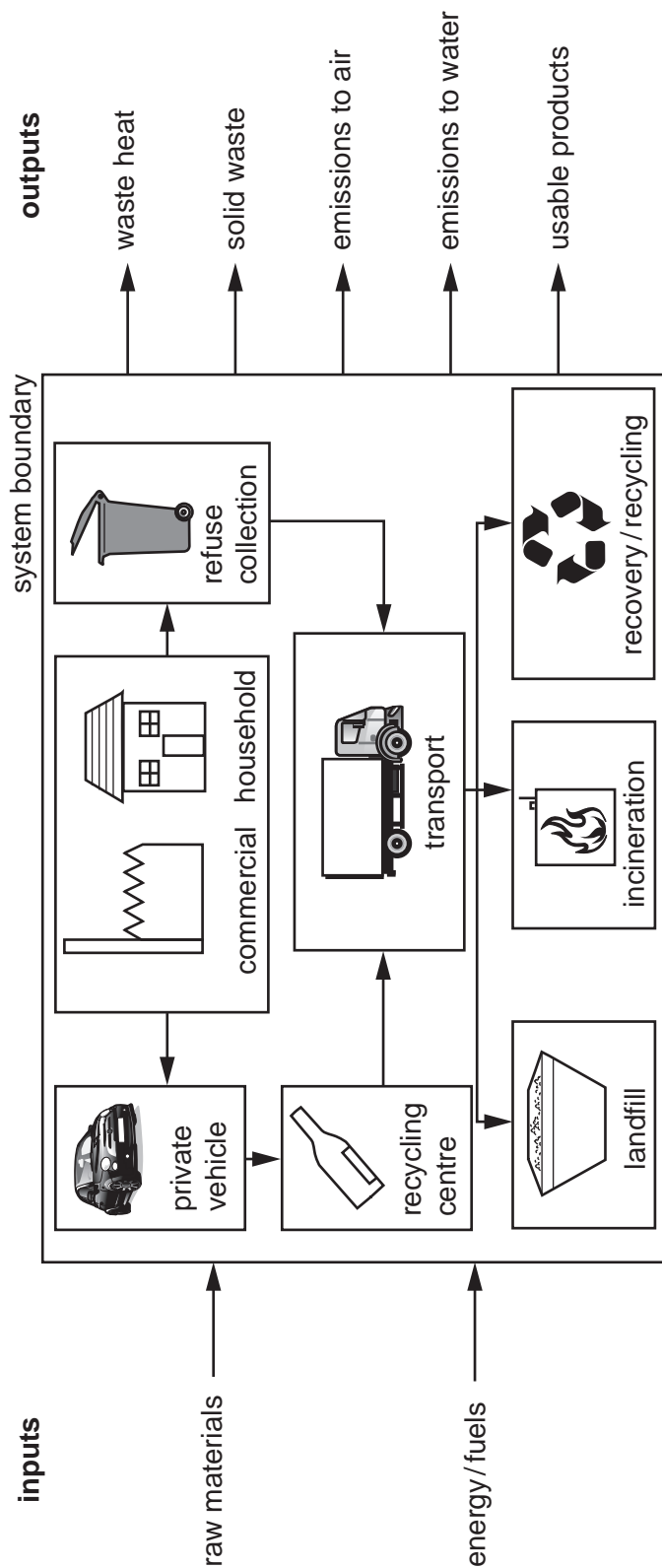


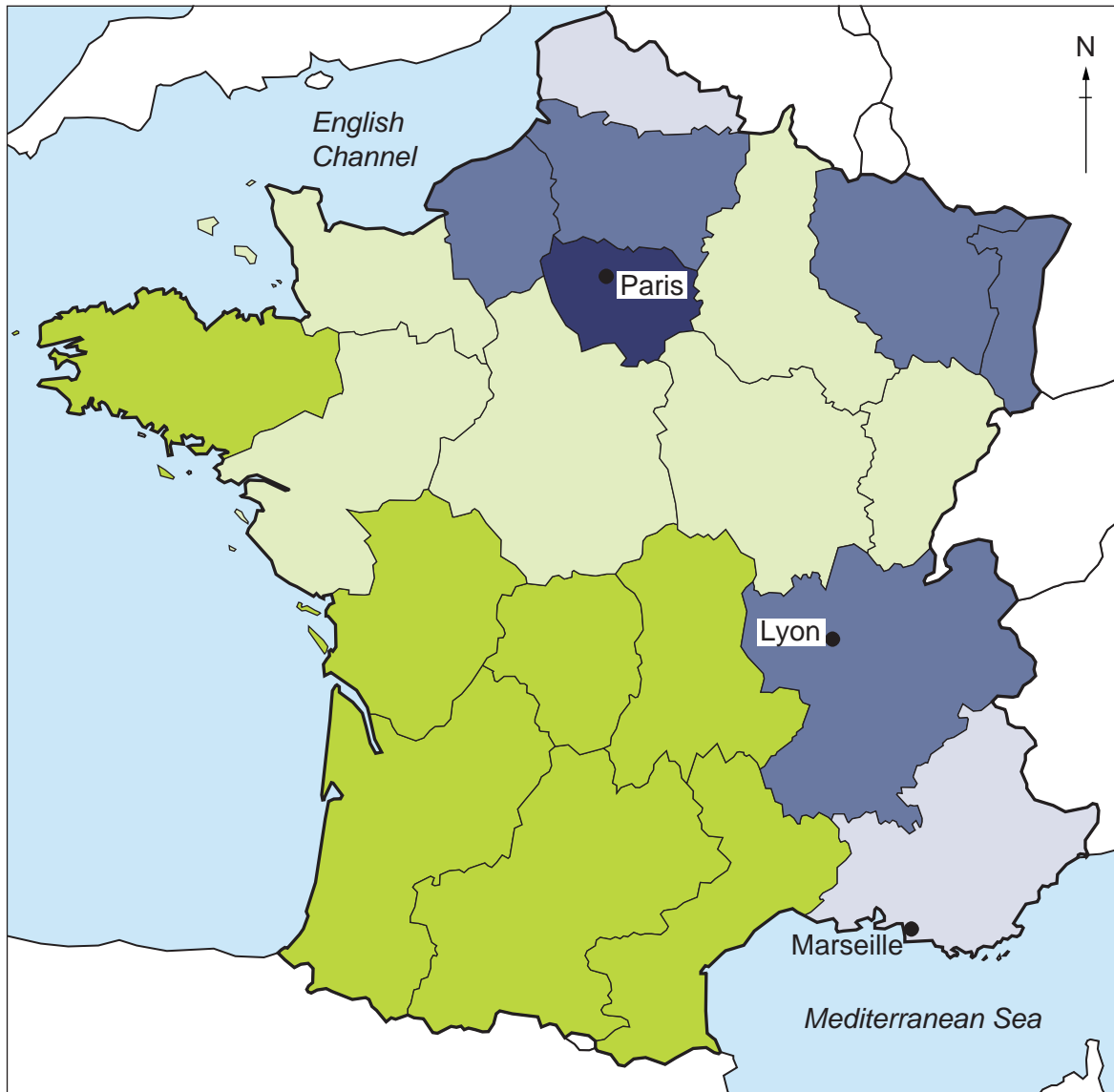

## Percentage of GDP from tourism for selected countries and one territory, 2014




