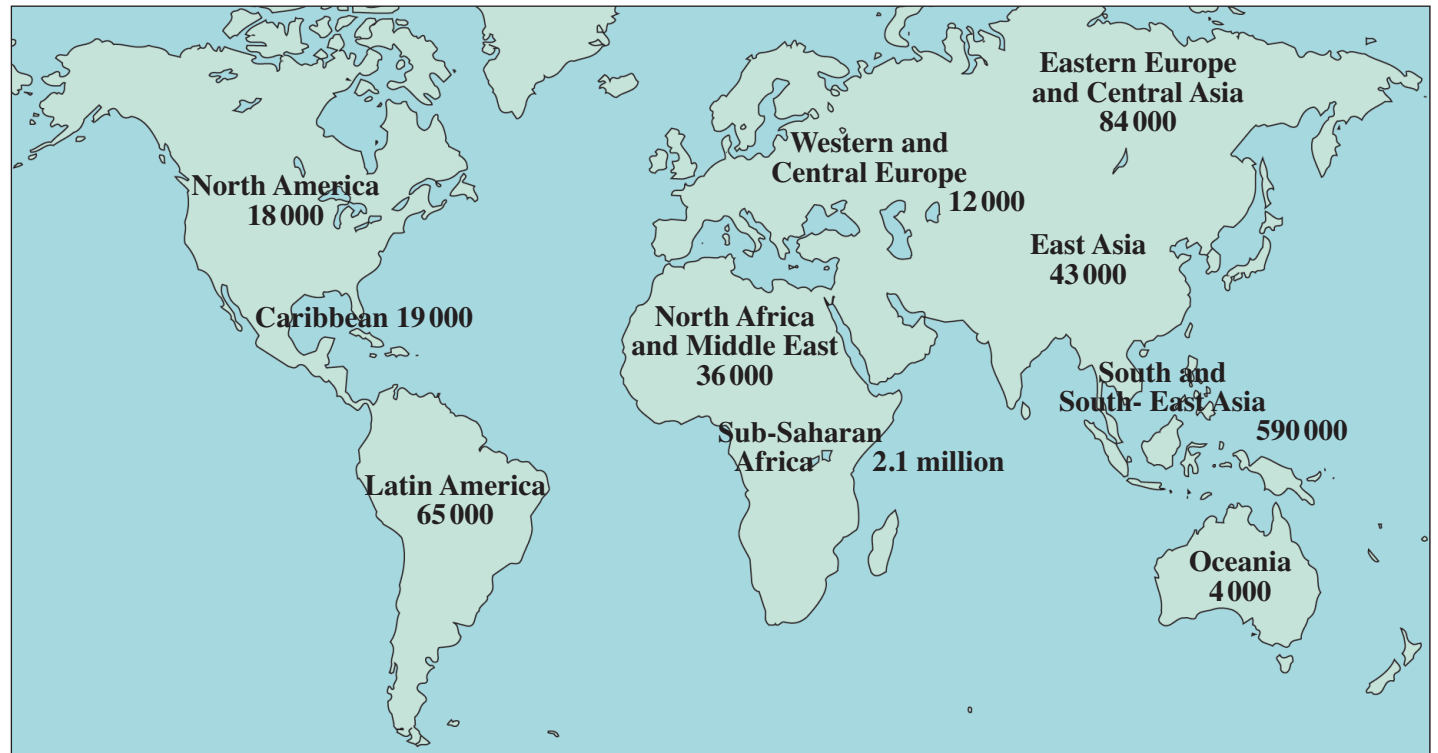

- (c) Explain how and why population changes naturally over time. [10]

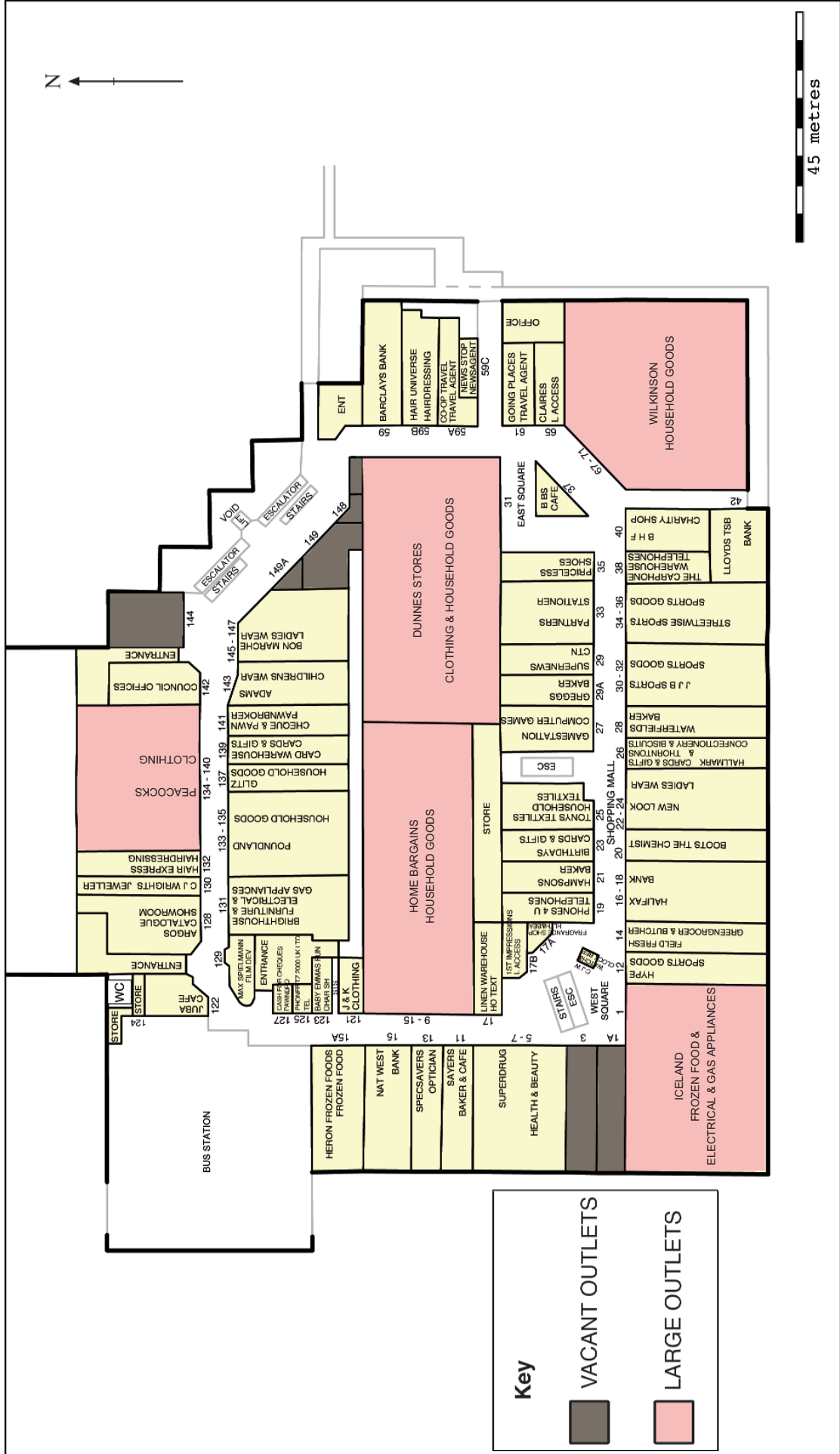
Figure 2: A Regenerated Area of Oslo, Norway
